The Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation is an independent Foundation formed under the will of Charlotte W. Newcombe, a Philadelphia philanthropist, to provide scholarships to mature second-career women students for undergraduate or graduate post-secondary education. These scholarships are available for partial tuition and indirect educational expenses, and may be used to cover off-campus internships which are part of the supervised program of the college.

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

1. Enrollment as a degree candidate at La Salle University for a minimum of six (6) credits during the term when the scholarship will be used.
2. Enrollment for a minimum of six (6) credits at La Salle University for at least one (1) semester prior to the term when the scholarship will be used.
3. Cumulative grade point average – minimum 2.50.
4. Academic level –
(A) Undergraduate: minimum of sixty (60) credits completed by the term when scholarship will be used.
(B) Graduate: minimum of one-half of the total credits required for degree must be completed by the term when scholarship will be used.
5. Age – at least twenty-five (25) years old.
6. Demonstrated financial need through completion of Free Application for Federal Student Aid. (Available in Student Financial Services Office for the current academic year).

The selection committee will be composed of representatives from the Student Financial Services Office and the Office of Continuing Studies. All funds will be awarded in the beginning of each academic year. Priority will be given to first-time Bachelor Degree Candidates. Depending on the amount of funding available and the eligible applicant pool, awards will be made for Fall and Spring. If a recipient fails to enroll for at least six credits in the spring or if their GPA falls below a 2.50 at the end of the Fall Semester the award for the Spring Semester will be cancelled. If your Spring award is cancelled you will be notified in writing. The committee will give special consideration to the life circumstances and family responsibilities of mature women students.
