The Greek community at La Salle University offers a unique opportunity for your students to become involved with the University community. Our 9 Greek organizations provide leadership development, community service opportunities, and brotherhood/sisterhood that lasts a lifetime. The University encourages students to go out and be involved with these groups as they are an asset to our community.

Here are a few brief facts about our Greek community:

- In the fall 2011 semester, they raised well over \$13,000 dollars for local and national charities, and collectively volunteered over 1000 hours in service to the University and local communities.
- Students who join Greek organizations have a better chance of persisting to graduation.
- In the fall 2011 semester, the sorority average GPA was higher than the all-women's average GPA.
- Many of the members of these organizations are involved with at least one other organization on campus.

Our women's organizations, Alpha Sigma Tau, Alpha Theta Alpha, Delta Phi Epsilon, and Gamma Phi Beta, will be holding their recruitment events the week on Jan. 30<sup>th</sup> to Feb. 3, 2012 in the student union. Our men's organizations, Alpha Chi Rho, Alpha Phi Delta, Phi Beta Sigma, Inc., Sigma Phi Epsilon, and Sigma Phi Lambda, will be holding their recruitment events the week of Feb. 6-10, 2012 in various locations around campus.

The University and the National Organizations do not in any way support involvement or activities of these groups. They are not supervised and involvement with these organizations is potentially dangerous. The following groups are not recognized by the University or their National Organizations: Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE), Gamma Sigma Sigma (Gamma Sig), Delta Sigma Phi (Delta Sig), and Phi Gamma Delta (FIJI).
