

**MODERN HANDLING SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA  
2011-2012**

1. Must be a Continuing Studies (Evening Division\*) student with an academic level of a minimum of fifteen (15) credits completed by the term when the scholarship will be used.  
\*Transfer credits are included toward the fifteen credits.
2. Student must be a Business major
3. Enrollment as an undergraduate degree candidate at La Salle University for a minimum of six (6) credits during the term when the scholarship will be used.
4. Enrollment as a part-time (6 credits) or full-time (12 credits) candidate at La Salle University for at least one semester, including summer, prior to the term when the scholarship will be used.
5. Cumulative grade point average – minimum 2.50
6. Demonstrated financial need through completion of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) \*
7. **Application deadline is August 1, 2011.**

The selection committee will be composed of representatives from the Student Financial Services Office and the College of Professional and Continuing Studies Office. All funds will be awarded in the beginning of each academic year. Depending on the amount of funding available and the eligible applicant pool, awards will be made for fall and spring semesters. If a recipient fails to enroll for at least six credits in the spring, or if their GPA falls below a 2.50 at the end of the fall semester, the award for the spring semester will be cancelled. If your spring award is cancelled you will be notified in writing.

Applicants who were not awarded a Modern Handling Scholarship are invited to reapply for consideration in subsequent academic years.

*\*Children of Modern Handling employees may apply whether they are day or evening students and the filing of a FAFSA is not required. However, you must list the parent's name and social security number on the application.*
