**Summary:** Detective and mystery film. Set in Chicago in the 1980s. Nico Toscani (Seagal) is Chicago detective with a past as a CIA operative in Cambodia during the Vietnam War. Nico has a long-standing grudge against a sadistic CIA interrogator whom he learns is now active in an illegal CIA operation in Nicaragua funded by drug smuggling.
