Summary: Action/adventure film set in Washington, D.C. and aboard Air Force One in the 1990s. The plane, with the President (Ford) aboard, is hijacked by Russian terrorists who got aboard by masquerading as journalists. The President, a Vietnam veteran pilot, retakes the plane singlehandedly.
