

## A4400 ALICE'S RESTAURANT (USA, 1969)

(Other titles: Restaurante de Alicia)

**Credits:** director, Arthur Penn ; writers, Venable Herndon, Arthur Penn

**Cast:** Arlo Guthrie, Pat Quinn, James Broderick

**Summary:** Comedy set in New York City and Stockbridge, Mass. in 1968. Arlo registers for the draft. He drops out of school, spends time in NYC with his father who has been hospitalized with Huntington's chorea, then visits the Brock's commune in Stockbridge where he gets arrested for littering. When Arlo is drafted and ordered to report for induction, he unsuccessfully feigns insanity, failing to impress the Army psychiatrist. But when he admits he was arrested for littering, he is rejected for military service.
