

## B4110 THE BEACH (USA, 2000)

(Other titles: La plage; La playa)

**Credits:** director, Danny Boyle ; writer, John Hodge ; novel, Alex Garland.

**Cast:** Leonardo DiCaprio, Tilda Swinton, Virginie Ledoyen, Guillaume Canet.

**Summary:** Action/adventure film set in Thailand in the 1990s. Richard (DiCaprio), a young nicotine-addicted traveler and pop-culture buff with a particular fascination with video games and Vietnam War movies, finds a map left by his suicidal neighbor. The map leads to a legendary island paradise inhabited by other adventure seeking youth of the virtual generation.
