**Cast:** Robert Shaw, Bruce Dern, Marthe Keller.

**Summary:** Thriller set in Florida in the 1970s. Palestinian Black September terrorists seek to slaughter the Super Bowl audience in the Orange Bowl using the Goodyear Blimp to deliver their explosives. The blimp pilot (Dern), who has been seduced and recruited by a female Palestinian, is an ex-Navy pilot and Vietnam POW who feels he was discarded by the Navy after the war.
