Summary: Action/adventure film set in contemporary California. Mike Danton (Prior) is among a number of innocent people shanghaied to be human targets for military training exercises run by ex-Special Forces colonel Hogan (Campbell). Hogan, who was discharged from the Army for excessive violence, now runs a school for mercenaries and demands realism to get his pupils into shape. Danton served under Hogan in Vietnam and ultimately turns the tables on him, killing all the mercenaries and turning Hogan into the prey.
