Summary: Melodrama set in 1950s France. Pierre (Kruger), a former pilot, has just returned home from the French-Indochinese war. He is suffering from amnesia as a result of the horrors he has experienced, and he begins to lead a pointless life. He meets a 12 year old girl who has been left at a local convent school, and a warm attachment develops between the two of them. Eventually people become suspicious this man-child relationship, and tragedy follows when the police encounter the pair, misinterpret a gesture of Pierre toward the girl, and shoot him.

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
