

**G2100 GA (NORTH VIETNAM, 1970)**

**Cast:** Tung Hung, Thanh Y, Huy Cong.

**Summary:** War film set in contemporary North Vietnam. Tan (Tung) is sent to work at a small railway station where he is assisted only by a woman and an old man. When the station is bombed by the Americans, everyone works to save the goods located at the station. Railway workers repairing the line find an unexploded bomb, but Tan manages to prevent it exploding with cleverness and bravery. The next military train is able to pass safely and continue to the front.
