Summary: Melodrama set in contemporary Sweden. Georgia (Sands), a black American singer, comes to Stockholm for a show. She meets Black American deserters (some real ones like Terry Whitmore) and Michael Winters (Benedict), an American photographer with whom she falls in love. But Georgia's assistant Alberta (Gentry) discourages this interracial romance. The deserters try to get Georgia to speak out for their cause, but she is not interested.
