Summary: Melodrama set in contemporary New York City. Jenny Marsh (Thomas), a young woman who is pregnant and unmarried, leaves her home in Connecticut for New York where she finds a job in an antique shop. There she meets Delano (Alda), a filmmaker. He is about to be drafted and suggests a marriage of convenience. Her baby will have a father and he will get a draft deferment. Their marriage of convenience gets complicated when they start to care for each other. Just before the baby is born, however, Delano learns his deferment has been denied.
