**Summary:** Melodrama set in contemporary South Dakota. Mixed race Vietnam veteran Johnny Vik (Hammack) runs afoul of the law for urinating in public. Sentenced to 30 days in jail, he escapes to the wilderness where he hallucinates about repression and his Indian and Christian heritage. He is befriended by a young girl and finds some ease at a cabin hideout until he is discovered and shot by a posse. A similar theme to the Billy Jack films.
