Summary: Melodrama set in contemporary South Dakota. Danny (Tabori), a draft dodger, seeks sanctuary on the Rosebud Indian Reservation. His disillusionment with the establishment is reinforced by Frank (Forster), a cynical Vietnam veteran and unofficial leader of the reservation. Frank believes his life has become meaningless and he recites a litany of woes in his drunken stupors.
