### **K5310 KILL ALEX KILL (USA, 1976)**

**Summary:** Gangster/revenge melodrama set in contemporary California. A Vietnam veteran and ex-POW returns to the U.S. after his release. He makes anti-war statements on TV. When he gets home, he finds his wife and children have been murdered. He learns that his brother, who was staying with his family at the time, owes money to drug dealing gangsters who carried out the executions. He then goes undercover to work for the Mafia, get close to the kingpin, and exact his revenge.
