**Summary:** Melodrama set in contemporary Houston, Tex. The sudden appearance of a Quan (Price), a young Amerasian boy and his ailing mother Lien (Chen) threatens to shatter the lives of an American family when the truth of the father's infidelity during the Vietnam War is revealed. Prejudice, hostility, and hatred take control. Craig Weston (Rogers) and wife Janet (Bedelia) find their already troubled marriage pushed to the edge by Craig's unwitting fatherhood and the reaction of his racist father-in-law (Hingle).
