

## M2575 MARINE BATTLEGROUND (USA/KOREA, 1966)

**Credits:** directors, Manli Lee, Milton Mann ; writers, Milton Mann, Han-chul Yu.

**Summary:** War film set in contemporary Vietnam and 1950s Korea. Nurse Young Hi Park (Yi) is a nurse serving in an American medical unit in Vietnam. She recounts the story of her childhood in Korea to reporter Nick Rawlins (Mahoney). She was orphaned during the siege of Inchon in 1950 but adopted by a platoon of American Marines, all but two of whom were slain thereafter. Inspired by their memory Young Hi became a nurse.
