

## M3020 MCBAIN (USA, 1991)

**Cast:** Christopher Walken, Maria Conchita Alonso, Michael Ironside.

**Summary:** Action/adventure film set in contemporary Colombia. In the aftermath of the Vietnam War, a group of Rangers led by Santos (Vennera) risk their lives to rescue POW Robert McBain (Walken). Eighteen years later, McBain is asked to pay back this debt by Santos's sister Cristina (Alonso) who is seeking revenge against the Colombian drug lords who killed her brother. McBain assembles a group of surviving Rangers to join Cristina and her rebel army as they wage war against the corrupt Colombian regime.
