

## M9180 MY SCIENCE PROJECT (USA, 1985)

**Summary:** Science fiction/fantasy set in the contemporary U.S. When his high school science teacher (Hopper) issues an ultimatum: turn in a science project or flunk, Mike Harlan (Stockwell) scavenges a military base's junk pile for a suitable gizmo. Unwittingly he has stolen a piece of hardware from an alien spaceship which the government buried back in the 1950's. The device can twist the dimensions of space and time. Among the scenes the device manifests is a firefight from the Vietnam War. Harlan and his friends must race to cut it off from its power source before it envelopes the world. Dennis Hopper (the science teacher) is a burned out ex-radical/hippie from the '60s.
