P2740 PARIAS DE LA GLOIRE (FRANCE, 1964)

(Other titles: Pariahs of glory)

Cast: Curt Jurgens, Maurice Ronet, Folco Lulli, Roland Lesaffre, Tiny Yong.

Summary: War film set in French Indochina in the early 1950s. A French company at a jungle outpost awaits reinforcements. A plane carrying an German planter (Jurgens) who was a German army officer during WWII makes a forced landing nearby. One of the French soldiers (Ronet) whose brother was killed by the Germans during the war takes an immediate dislike to the German. By no small coincidence, the planter was actually the officer who killed the Frenchman's brother. But under Viet Minh attack the two are brought together and die reconciled.
