Series summary: Action/adventure series set in contemporary Pensacola, Fla. Lt.Col. Bill Kelly (Brolin) commands and trains the Sea Dragons, an elite Marine multi-skill task force.

Summary: Kate Anderson (Niven) investigates her deceased husband's past after she finds a picture of a woman whom she thinks he had an affair with. She finds out he fathered a daughter (Nguyen) in Vietnam before she met him and he died just a few days before effecting a reconciliation with the young woman.

Summary: A terrorist bomber targets members of Col. Bill Kelly's old Vietnam unit which was mistakenly napalmed the village of Bien Nhon when they were given the wrong coordinates to attack. Two Vietnamese nationals preparing a legal case against the U.S. action fall under suspicion, but in the end, Joe Damian (Johnston), the embittered former operations officer who issued the incorrect coordinates is found to be the perpetrator.
