Summary: War film set in South Vietnam in the 1960s. ARVN soldier Le Mai is wounded and captured. His NVA captors take him to their field hospital. Le Mai is afraid and attempts to escape, but female doctor Thu Trang saves him. When he recovers, Le Mai, a former sculptor, creates a statue of Thu Thang in gratitude.
