

## **P3610 PHONE BOOTH (USA, 2002)**

**Credits:** director, Joel Schumacher ; writer, Larry Cohen.

**Cast:** Colin Farrell, Kiefer Sutherland, Forest Whitaker.

**Summary:** Thriller set in contemporary New York. Stu Shepard (Farrell) is a fast-talking public relations agent who cheats and manipulates anyone in a position to get him what he wants. He curiously picks up the ringing phone in a New York City phone booth. The caller, talking from a nearby building with a high-powered rifle covering the street, is a psychopath (Sutherland) who has singled out Shepard to pay for his sins. The caller brags about having assassinated other dishonorable people (a crooked businessman, a pedophile, etc.) and describes his experience in Vietnam and being spat on when he came home – though he later denies being a veteran.
