Summary: Science fiction thriller set in contemporary Central America. Major Alan 'Dutch' Schaefer (Schwarzenegger) and his band of soldiers-of-fortune (including several Vietnam veterans) are recruited by the CIA to rescue hostages held by guerrilla fighters in a Central American jungle. But the Major and his men encounter an enemy more deadly than any on Earth -- because the Predator is not of this Earth. The rescue team members are picked off one by one until the Major is the only human left stop the alien hunter.
