P7475 PRIVATE DUTY NURSES (USA, 1971)

Cast: Kathy Cannon, Joyce Williams, Pegi Boucher, Morris Buchanan, Dennis Redfield.

Summary: Melodrama set in contemporary California. The second of Roger Corman's five nurse films. Spring, Lynn and Lola are young nurses enrolled in an experimental pilot program at an urban California hospital where they must confront drug traffickers, racism and murder. One supporting character, Domino (Redfield), is a Vietnam veteran biker who still suffers from a head wound received in Vietnam.
