Summary: Motorcycle/adventure film set in contemporary Arizona. Special Forces and Vietnam veteran Ben Stryker (Henriksen) and his disabled Army buddy Tick Rand (Kennedy) have settled in a decaying Arizona mining town. Then the 'Savages' motorcycle gang led by the brutish Pig Iron (Forsythe) arrives to terrorize the town. Ben and Tick help the townsfolk defend themselves.
