

S3322 SECRET HONOR (USA, 1984)

(Other titles: Last testament of Richard M. Nixon; Political myth)

Credits: director, Robert Altman ; writers/play, Donald Freed, Arnold M. Stone.

Cast: Philip Baker Hall.

Summary: Biographical monologue set in the final hours before Richard Nixon's resignation from the U.S. Presidency. The play theorizes that Nixon did not resign because of the Watergate cover-up but was motivated instead by his secret decision to thwart the plans of a cabal of businessmen to continue their control of the White House. Includes references to the Vietnam War peace negotiations.
