Series summary: Science fiction series set in the contemporary U.S. As a child, Sydney Bloom (Lori Singer) survives a car wreck which kills her sister and father and leaves her mother brain damaged. Years later, Sydney accidentally 'plugs in' to virtual reality through her computer. She finds an ability in herself to enter into the human mind by using of VR. This brings her to the attention of a mysterious organization called 'The Committee,' which makes her an offer she cannot refuse.
