Summary: Melodrama set in the U.S. and Thailand in 1985. Based on the real-life experiences of Donald Scott, a former US aid worker with the Montagnards in Vietnam. Recounts the efforts of Scott (Gross) and a group of ex-Green Berets (led by McRaney) to free Montagnard refugees from camps in Thailand and bring them to the United States, honoring promises made to the Montagnards at the close of the Vietnam War.
