Summary: Action/adventure film set in contemporary California. When growing numbers of incoming oil workers become more than the local police force of a backwoods California town can manage, Aaron Arnold (Kristofferson) is called in to try and maintain order. A Vietnam vet, he brings in some of his buddies, and soon gets the town under control. The power goes to their heads and they virtually take over the town. Aaron's brother Ben (Vincent) recruits his own group of vigilantes to put the rogue law officers out of business.
