V7660 VONG HOA TRUOC MO (VIETNAM, 1987)

Summary: Historical melodrama set in South Vietnam in the 1960s. The spy Nguyen Thanh Luan is assigned to the Diem family's inner circle as a reward for loyalty. He is assigned to transport opium from Laos to Vietnam. When the South Vietnamese military overthrows Diem, he discovers Luan's real identity but allows the spy to live in the hope he will eventually work against Diem's enemies.
