**Summary:** Melodrama set in July and August 1969 in a middle class Catskills resort. Pearl Kantrowitz (Lane) a vaguely dissatisfied mother of two has an affair with a traveling garment salesman (Mortensen). Backgrounds include references to the Vietnam War, a visit to Woodstock, and the Apollo moon landing.
