Summary: War film set in South Vietnam in 1972. Five young Marines, four of them Black, leap out of a helicopter and into the unknown. They all joined the Marines for different reason, but they find themselves in the same place-- bound together in a desperate struggle for survival-- lost in a jungle minefield on a mission to rescue some POWs.
