Ehrhart, W. D. (Phila., PA) [Letter (TLS Mar 8, 1988) suggesting contributors for VNG; Manuscript speech "Steeling hubcaps" given at the Conference on Youth, Militarism & Alternatives (Chicago, Ill.: June 3, 1988); Letter (TLS Dec 2, 1988) discusses K. Tal's dissertation, poetry collections and memoirs he has for sale, and other works he has published; Letter (TLS Dec 15, 1988) transmitting books K. Tal ordered and discussing possible contributors to VNG; Postcard (San Francisco, Feb 24, 1989) responding to first issue of VNG; Letter (TLS July 5, 1989) regarding K.
