OF LIVING AT LA SALLE

Convenience

The units that comprise the residential community at La Salle University are within walking distance of all campus facilities. Academic and non-academic resources are just steps away and include the library, recreational facilities, and social and cultural venues. All units are wired for access to the La Salle network, with every bedroom having a connection to the Internet.

Security

Access to all residences is controlled by an ID card monitoring system; entranceways are monitored by a closed-circuit TV.

Affordability

Graduate standard (double occupancy) apartment rent is as little as \$3,145 per semester; single apartment rent is \$3,450 per semester. Graduate apartments include basic furniture, Internet access and all utilities (long-distance telephone and cable service not included).

Safety

Life safety systems include smoke detectors, direct notification to emergency personnel, and regular evacuation drills.

Food Service

A meal plan is optional for apartment residents. For more information, visit www.lasalle.edu/businessaffairs/foodservice.

Parking

Parking in any University lot requires registration with Safety and Security.

Transportation

La Salle provides shuttle bus service during the Fall and Spring semesters. Students also have convenient access to public transportation through the SEPTA (www.septa.org) station at Broad Street and Olney Avenue. Escort service is available and provided by La Salle Safety and Security.

To apply for campus housing, please complete the steps below.

1. Print an Application/Occupancy Agreement for Graduate Housing at www.lasalle.edu/gradhousing. Please note that once you return this agreement and an assignment is made, you will be subject to cancellation fees as listed on the Occupancy Agreement.
2. Print an Early Arrival Request Form, if you require early arrival.
3. Complete and return the Application/Occupancy Agreement and the Early Occupancy Request, if needed, with your \$200 non-refundable housing deposit to:

You will receive written notification of your housing assignment.

Application Deadlines:

For Fall semester, housing applications will be accepted beginning April 1, and assignments will be made on a rolling basis.

For Spring semester, housing applications will be accepted beginning Oct. 1, and assignments will be made on a rolling basis beginning in early December.

Once you submit your application and are assigned a room, you will be subject to cancellation fees. You must notify Administrative Services as soon as possible to cancel your application if you have made alternate housing plans. The only way to avoid cancellation fees is to cancel prior to being assigned a unit.
