Traditional Application Review

Any applicant can submit a traditional application. Those interested in Nursing, Communication Sciences and Disorders, the Honors Program, Business Scholars Co-Op Program, four-year BS/MBA in Accounting, and international students must submit a traditional application.

Requirements

- Application for admission
- Official high school transcript
- A recommendation letter
- A personal statement (not graded)
- Official SAT or ACT results

Test-Flexible Application Review

Any applicant except those interested in Nursing, Communication Sciences and Disorders, the Honors Program, Business Scholars Co-Op Program, four-year B.S./MBA in Accounting, and international students can submit their a application for Test-Flexible review.

Requirements

- Application for admission
- Official high school transcript
- A recommendation letter
- A personal statement (not graded)
- Either a Test-Flexible Essay or Test-Flexible Interview

Test-Flexible Essay

- Can be submitted via The Common Application or La Salle's Application or it can be emailed to admiss@lasalle.edu. When emailing, please include your full-name, date of birth, and "Test-Flexible Essay" in the body of the email.
- Should be approximately 300 words in length and answer **ONE** of the following questions:
 - Why are you applying test-flexible at La Salle University?
 - Why do you wish to join the La Salle University community?
 - What are your long-term plans either academically, personally, or professionally?
 - Please tell the La Salle University Admissions Committee about your involvement and/or leadership roles in extracurricular activities. Which activities are you most proud of and why?

Test-Flexible Interview

- Is also known as an Explorer Interview and is approximately 30 minutes in length.
- Can be scheduled during an Open House. If you wish to participate in an Explorer Interview during an Open House please select an interview time in the "Sub Events" section of the Open House registration form.
- Is offered Monday-Friday during our Campus Tour and Admission Meeting. When signing up for this event, please check the Test-Flexible Interview indicator in the registration form and we will schedule you for an interview while you're on campus for your tour.

- Can be a virtual or phone interview, if you are unable to visit campus. To sign up for this type of interview, please complete the form at lasalle.edu/explorerinterview.
