

Class of 2018 – Six Months Out

The following provides a data summation of the La Salle Class of 2018 graduates' careers, service, and educational pathways six months after they've graduated.

This survey was disseminated in November of 2018 to a total of 394 graduates, 74 of which completed the survey (19%), and 8 of which partially completed the survey (2%).

It is important to note that, because the participants chose to respond to the survey, that the results may not necessarily be representative of the cohort as a whole, as those who are employed, enrolled in continuing education (CE), or engaged in service are more likely to participate in a survey than if they were unemployed or not otherwise engaged.

This survey was disseminated in June of 2018 to a total of 406 graduates, 131 of which completed the survey (32%), and 26 of which partially completed the survey (6%).

It is important to note that, because the participants chose to respond to the survey, that the results may not necessarily be representative of the cohort as a whole, as those who are employed, enrolled in continuing education (CE), or engaged in service are more likely to participate in a survey than if they were unemployed or not otherwise engaged.
