Satisfactory Academic Progress Calculation for Aid Eligibility

In order to continue receiving financial aid, a student must maintain satisfactory academic progress towards the completion of a program of study. Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) is determined through two measurements: successfully earning a set percentage of all attempted credits, and maintaining a cumulative grade point average (GPA) based on grade level. Below are details regarding both measurements.

The following chart can be used to determine your academic progress for financial aid eligibility. Students must successfully earn 67% of all attempted credits. Your SAP percentage is calculated by dividing your EARNED CREDIT HOURS by the ATTEMPTED CREDIT HOURS from your unofficial transcript, which is available through the La Salle portal.

IMPORTANT: *While this calculation will provide you with your term completion rate, this is for informational purposes only and is not an official measurement of SAP.*

In addition to completing a certain number of attempted credits, all students are required to achieve the cumulative GPA as listed for each level:

Credits Earned	Required Cumulative GPA
1 - 23	1.50
24-53	1.75
54 and above	2.00
Graduate Students	2.00
