LCCC-La Salle Dual Admission Students: Please refer to the Dual Admission application for eligibility requirements. Students interested in applying to La Salle through the Dual Admission program must sign the Dual Admission Application before completing 45 college-level credits. The Dual Admission Agreement includes a Core-to-Core component. Under the Dual Admission agreement, La Salle University's Core will essentially be fulfilled by the Core at Lehigh Carbon Community College. In order to meet the requirements of La Salle's Core, students must take CORE "qualifiers" at La Salle: REL 100 Religion Matters and ENG 210 College Writing II: Research. Students must take these at La Salle as there are no equivalents at LCCC.

Non-Dual Admission students who transfer to La Salle University will be required to complete the entire La Salle Core, which includes courses in a number of disciplines. Coursework can be taken at La Salle or prior to transfer. Seek advisement for course options and visit the La Salle website, <u>www.lasalle.edu</u>, to view the current course catalog.

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Notes for Dual Admission Applicants:

- 1) Dual Admission Intent to Enroll forms must be submitted before 45 college credits are earned.
- 2) When the student is within one year of completing the associate's degree, the Dual Admission application must be submitted on La Salle University's website, <u>www.lasalle.edu</u>,. Applications are free.
- 3) All Dual Admission applicants for full-time day programs will be eligible for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.

Additional Admission Requirements for all Full-Time Day BSN Applicants:

- 1) High school transcripts or GED results
- 2) Two letters of recommendation (one of which must be academic in nature)
- 4) Essay or personal statement
- 5) SAT or ACT scores if taken within the past three years, composite score received on the SAT must total a minimum of 1080. If SAT or ACT scores are not available or do not qualify, students will be required to take the ATI-TEAS exam. Expected scores must be in the proficient range or higher. Students must submit test scores at the time of application.
- 6) Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 as well as a science GPA of 3.0 or better (science GPA includes Anatomy and Physiology I and II, Microbiology and Chemistry).
- 7) Students are permitted to repeat one science one time in order to obtain the required 3.0 science GPA.
- 8) Students must complete all science prerequisite courses by the end of the spring semester prior to their intended fall start date. Students will be permitted to take summer classes in an attempt to complete their liberal arts/CORE requirements, but no science class can be completed the summer prior to the intended fall start.
- 9) Students are required to submit official transcripts after each semester in which additional coursework was earned. It is the students' responsibility to make sure that La Salle has their most recent and updated transcripts before starting classes. All final transcripts MUST be received before attending La Salle. Failure to comply will result in a hold on all future registration at La Salle.
- 10) The School of Nursing and Health Sciences is utilizing CastleBranch for background screening and immunization tracking. The student will enroll in CastleBranch when accepted into the nursing major. Any students with a positive background check will not be permitted to start the nursing major.

Additional Notes:

- 1) Transfer students will spend a minimum of three years at La Salle in order to complete the degree requirements for the BSN.
- 2) BIO 124 Nutrition doesn't satisfy the Nutrition requirement for this major unless taught by a Registered Dietician.
- 3) The maximum number of credits that a student may transfer to La Salle is 70. Additional courses beyond the Associate degree can be taken at LCCC to meet program requirements at La Salle.
- 4) All full-time day applicants will be eligible for the merit-based Founder's Scholarship. The award amount will depend on grade point average and quality of curriculum.
- 5) The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is offered to all full-time day transfer applicants who are members of PTK with a 3.5 cumulative GPA or above. Proof of membership is required to qualify for this scholarship.
- 6) Students are strongly advised to use this guide with the assistance of Transfer Services at LCCC. The information in this transfer guide is subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to check periodically with Transfer Services for up-to-date information and to contact the Assistant Dean at La Salle, listed below, for advisement on major requirements that can be taken at LCCC.
