Manor-La Salle Dual Admission Students: Please refer to the Dual Admission application for eligibility requirements. Students interested in applying to La Salle through the Dual Admission program must sign the Dual Admission Application before completing 45 college-level credits. The Dual Admission Agreement includes a Core-to-Core component. Under the Dual Admission agreement, La Salle University's Core will essentially be fulfilled by the Core at Manor College. In order to meet the requirements of La Salle's Core, students must take **CORE Qualifiers** – one Computer Science course and either a Psychology or Sociology course – at La Salle if they have not taken a course at Manor that will fulfill this requirement. See advising notes on reverse side.

Non-Dual Admission students who transfer to La Salle University will be required to complete the entire La Salle Core, which includes specific courses in a number of disciplines. Coursework can be taken at La Salle or prior to transfer. Seek advisement for course options and visit the La Salle website, www.lasalle.edu, to view the current course catalog.

**Although exemption determined through credit by examination is an option at Manor, please note, students will be required to take a Computer Science course at La Salle if CS 105 or 106 is not taken at Manor.*

IMPORTANT NOTES ON OTHER SIDE

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Advising Notes Related to Core Qualifier – For Dual Admission Students:

- 1) Dual Admission students who take any PS (Psychology) or SO (Sociology) course, except for SO 104 Intro to Criminal Justice and SO 202 Practice and Theory in Child Welfare and Mental Health, at Manor will satisfy La Salle's Psychology/Sociology Core Qualifier.
- 2) Students who take either CS 105 or 106 (as opposed to being exempt by exam) at Manor will satisfy La Salle's Computer Science Core Qualifier. CS 105 is preferred over 106.

Advising Notes Related to Major Course Requirements:

- 1) Students who take both MH 203 and 204 Statistics I and II at Manor will satisfy La Salle's required BUS 202 Applied Quantitative Methods for Business. MH 203 or 204 alone will not satisfy the BUS 202 requirement.
- 2) BA 102 satisfies La Salle's BUS 204 Principles of Marketing with Applications; BA 103 satisfies BUS 303 Legal and Ethical Environment of Business; BA 203 or 209 satisfies BUS 203 Organizational Behavior and Skill Development (however BA 209 is preferred); BA 216 satisfies BUS 208 Fundamentals of Financial Management.
- 3) EC 101 satisfies La Salle's ECN 150 Intro Macroeconomics; EC 102 satisfies ECN 201 Intro Microeconomics.
- 4) AC 105 Financial Accounting satisfies La Salle's BUS 101 Intro to Financial Accounting; AC 203 satisfies BUS 207 Managerial Accounting.
- 5) For general **Electives**, note that pre-college level courses, such as MH080 and MH090, do not meet this requirement. Please seek advisement on course selection and transferability. See notes above regarding courses that satisfy La Salle's Core Qualifier requirement.
- 6) Non-Dual Admission students need to complete the La Salle Core as part of earning a B.B.A. at La Salle. HS 110 History of Music and HS 111 History of Art are both transferable courses, either one of which will satisfy a Fine Arts/Language Core requirement at La Salle. HS 101 fulfills a History core requirement and HS 102 can be used to fulfill another core requirement. All other HS courses at Manor transfer as History electives. Please seek advisement.
- 7) The number of needed electives will depend on non-college level courses taken at Manor that will reduce the number of credits allowed in transfer.

Additional Notes:

- 1) The maximum number of credits that a student may transfer to La Salle is 70. Additional courses beyond the Associate degree can be taken at Manor to meet program requirements at La Salle. **A transfer student must complete at least half the major courses at La Salle.**
- 2) Students are required to submit official transcripts after each semester in which additional coursework was earned. It is the students' responsibility to make sure that La Salle has their most recent and updated transcripts before starting classes. All final transcripts **MUST** be received before attending La Salle. Failure to comply will result in a hold on all future registration at La Salle.
- 3) Students are strongly advised to use this guide with the assistance of the Manor College Transfer Center. The information in this transfer guide is subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to check periodically with the Transfer Center for up-to-date information and to contact the Assistant Dean at La Salle, listed below, for advisement on major requirements that can be taken at Manor. Following this guide does not guarantee the transfer of credit or admission to La Salle University.
