



Frequently Asked Questions

Who can apply to the Explorer Shadow Program?

All students are eligible. If you conducted a shadow in a previous year, you are welcome to participate again by reapplying each year and participating in orientation.

What is a job shadow and how will it benefit me?

You will "shadow" the host through a typical day's activities. The day might include touring the office or place of business, meeting other staff members who work in different roles at the company, observing meetings, and working on small projects. A job shadow is also an ideal time to ask questions, which you should prepare in advance.



When can we apply by?

Fall: October 13 Spring: February 16

When do shadows take place?

During each semester, it will be up to the student and their assigned host to schedule a shadow date before the semester ends.

Where can I apply to the program?

In the Explorer Shadow Program SharePoint Site, under the second folder in the Documents tab, you can find an application for each program semester. Once you have completed the application you will need to attend Orientation in order to be eligible to participate in the program. Students who have participated in the program before only need to attend Orientation once an academic year.

How do I get to the shadow location?

You must provide your own transportation to and from the job shadow site. Please see the Transportation Guide under the resources folder for more information.
