Manor-La Salle Dual Admission Students: This Dual Admission partnership allows Manor students to take four Nursing courses (NUR 201, 202, 203 and 204) at La Salle during their second year at Manor College. Admission requirements must be met in order to progress into the BSN program. After graduating from Manor, students take one additional Nursing course (NUR 205) over the summer at La Salle prior to matriculating into the BSN program. The BSN can be completed in two years provided students appropriately sequence and complete the remaining coursework.

Please NOTE: Transfer students who do not follow this <u>specialized</u> Nursing program (for example, those who follow the regular pre-Nursing A.S. at Manor), will spend a minimum of three years at La Salle in order to complete the degree requirements for the BSN.

Please refer to the Dual Admission agreement for eligibility requirements. Students interested in applying to La Salle through the Dual Admission program must sign the Intent to Enroll form at the beginning of their program at Manor, indicating their interest in this specialized Nursing program. The Dual Admission Agreement includes a Core-to-Core component. Under the Dual Admission agreement, La Salle University's Core will essentially be fulfilled by the Core at Manor College. In order to meet the requirements of La Salle's Core, students must take one CORE "qualifier" at La Salle, REL 100: Religion Matters. This course must be taken at La Salle because there is no equivalent course offered at the Manor.

Non-Dual Admission students who transfer to La Salle University will be required to complete the entire La Salle Core, which includes courses in a number of disciplines. Coursework can be taken at La Salle or prior to transfer. Seek advisement for course options and visit the La Salle website, www.lasalle.edu, to view the current course catalog.

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Additional Notes for Dual Admission Applicants:

- 1) The Dual Admission Intent to Enroll form must be completed at the start of the student's program at Manor.
- 2) The Dual Admission application must be completed on La Salle University's website, <u>www.lasalle.edu</u> within one year prior to earning the associate's degree. It is free to apply online.
- 3) Manor transcripts must be submitted at the end of year one at Manor. Students must possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 as well as a 3.0 Science GPA. They must provide acceptable TEAS exam (proficient level or higher) or SAT/ACT scores (SAT of 1080 or higher from within the last three years) to progress in the program.
- 4) All La Salle Nursing (NUR) courses must be completed with at least a 'C+' or better in each course as well as maintaining a La Salle NUR semester GPA of 2.75 and a 3.0 or higher Manor GPA in order to progress in the program. A minimum grade of 'C' is required for all transfer courses.
- Final official transcripts must be sent as soon as the final semester is completed and associate's degree conferred.
- 6) Dual Admission applicants for full-time day programs will be eligible for the Dual Admission Achievement Scholarship.

Admission Requirements for all Full-Time Day BSN Applicants (Dual Admission and regular transfer):

- 1) High school transcripts or GED results
- 2) Two letters of recommendation; one must be academic in nature
- 3) An essay or personal statement
- 4) Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 as well as a science GPA of 3.0 or better (science GPA includes Anatomy and Physiology I and II, Microbiology and Chemistry).
- 5) Students are permitted to repeat one science one time in order to obtain the required 3.0 science GPA.
- 6) Students must complete all science prerequisite courses by the end of the spring semester prior to their intended fall start date. Students will be permitted to take summer classes in an attempt to complete their liberal arts/CORE requirements, but no science class can be completed the summer prior to the intended fall start.
- 7) Official transcripts must be sent from all previous colleges attended. It is the students' responsibility to make sure that La Salle has their most recent and updated transcripts before starting classes. All final transcripts MUST be received before attending La Salle. Failure to comply will result in a hold on all future registration at La Salle.
- 8) The School of Nursing and Health Sciences is utilizing CastleBranch for background screening and immunization tracking. The student will enroll in CastleBranch when accepted into the nursing major. Any students with a positive background check will not be permitted to start the nursing major.

Additional Notes:

- 1) The maximum number of credits that a student may transfer to La Salle is 70.
- 2) All full-time day applicants will be eligible for the merit-based Founder's Scholarship. The award amount will depend on grade point average and quality of curriculum.
- 3) The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is offered to full-time day transfer applicants who are members of PTK with a 3.5 cumulative GPA or above. Proof of membership is required to qualify for this scholarship.
- 4) Clinical-ready Nursing students begin at La Salle in the fall term only.
- 5) Students are strongly advised to use this guide with the assistance of transfer services at Manor. The information in this transfer guide is subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to check periodically with transfer services for up-to-date information and to contact the Assistant Dean at La Salle, listed below, for advisement on major requirements that can be taken at Manor. Following this guide does not guarantee the transfer of credit or admission to La Salle University.
