FIFA Fever

The 2026 FIFA World Cup will be hosted in the United States during a truly historic year—the 250th anniversary of the nation’s independence. Philadelphia, one of the official host cities, will welcome multiple World Cup matches as part of this global tournament. Students will experience the excitement of the World Cup right here on campus during the La Salle Summer STEAM Enrichment Camp. In addition to their exploration of science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics, students will learn about the rich history and culture of soccer while celebrating teamwork, sportsmanship, and global unity through the world’s most popular sport.

The La Salle STEAM Summer Enrichment Camp offers all students entering 1st – 9th grade (as of September 2026) inclusive, engaging, and integrated learning experiences across all subject areas. Supervised by university faculty, our teachers are prepared to differentiate instruction to maximize each child’s learning and success, motivating students to want to learn through hands-on, indoor, and outdoor activities using evidence-based practices. Students will have opportunities to play games, explore, create and make art, learn new sports, and practice personal wellness techniques as a part of their camp experience.

The summer camp students must bring their own lunch each day. Morning and afternoon snacks and drinks will be provided.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Location: The La Salle Summer STEAM Camp will be held on the main campus of La Salle University at 1900 W. Olney Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19141 in Hayman Hall.

Dates & Times: The program runs from **Monday, July 6, 2026 – Friday, July 24, 2026**. The camp day starts at 8:00 AM and ends at 4:00 PM.

Tuition: Tuition is **\$500 per student** (a **non-refundable \$50 deposit** and a \$450 registration fee are included in the tuition). Scholarships are available for partnership schools.

Once your deposit has been received, additional camp forms will be sent to you. Payments can be made via cash, check, or money orders. We do **not** have any form of electronic payment. All payments can either be mailed or dropped off in-person. **Please do not mail cash.**

Deadlines: Registration opens **Monday, March 2, 2026**. All camp registration forms and tuition are due **Friday, June 5, 2026**.
