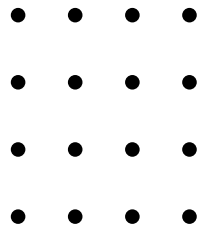


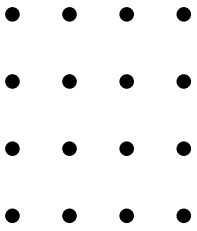

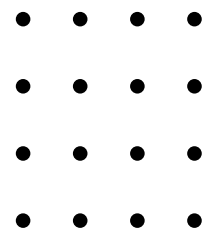


What Is It?

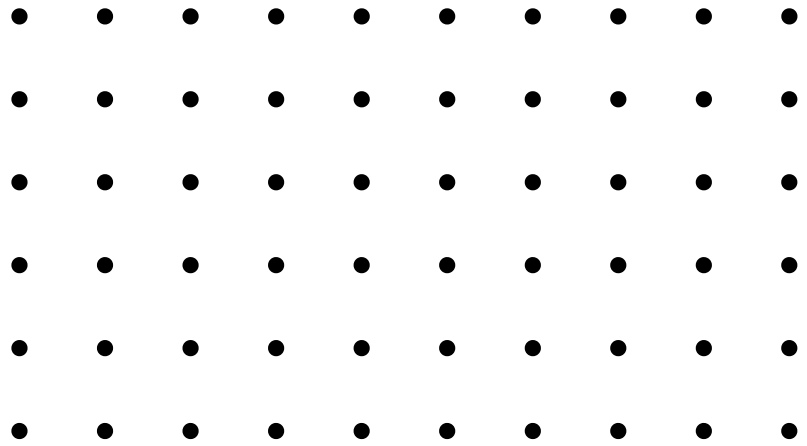


The Explorer Shadow Program is a joint effort of the Office of Alumni Engagement, the University Career Center, and the participating departments/programs.

The one-day shadow experience allows La Salle students to “shadow”, or observe, a professional to get a behind-the-scenes look at a specific job or company.

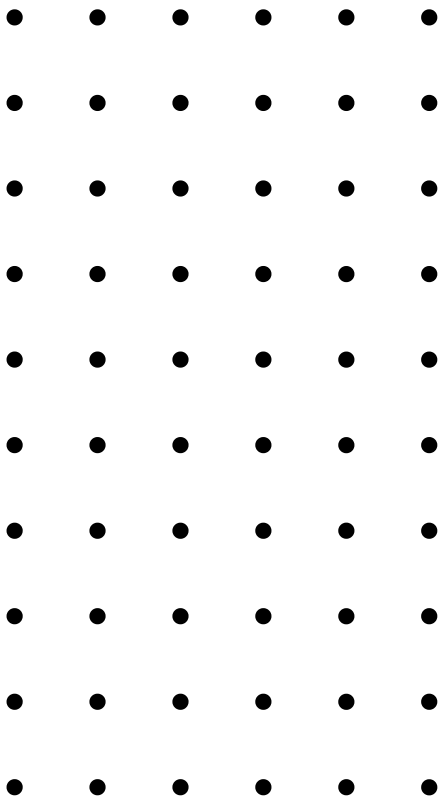


Information For Job Shadow Hosts

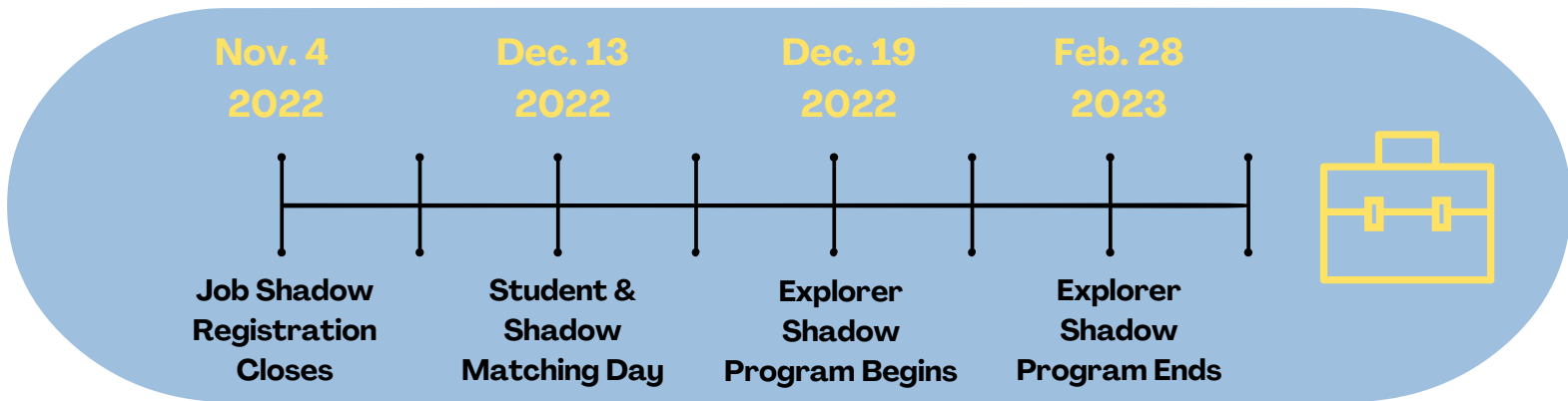
**ALL JOB SHADOWS WILL BE HELD DURING WINTER BREAK

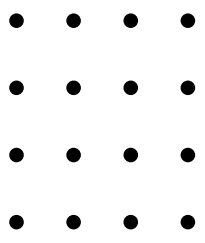
All job shadows will be held during Winter Break (12/19/22 – 1/13/23) or a mutually convenient date by 2/28/23.

Information For Students

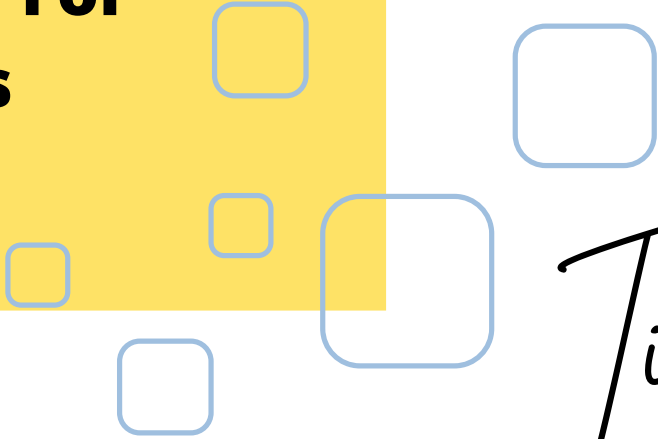

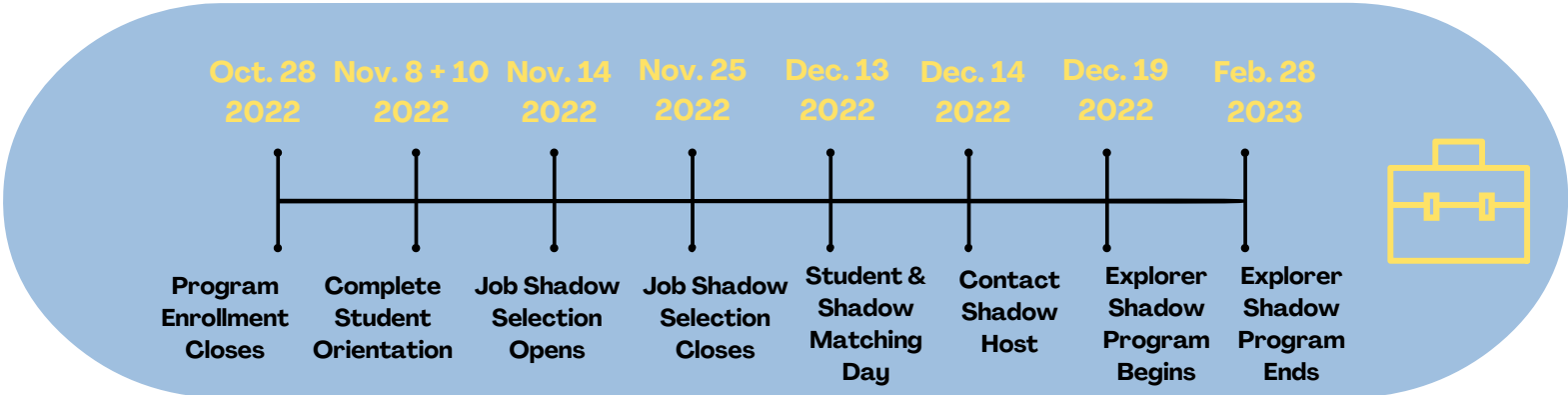
Should COVID restrictions in place at the time of the shadow preclude an in-person experience, the student and host will conduct a virtual job shadow.



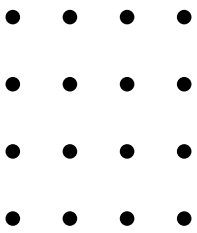

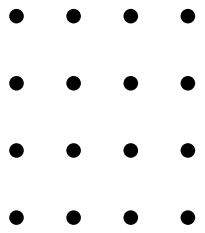

Information For Academic Departments & Programs

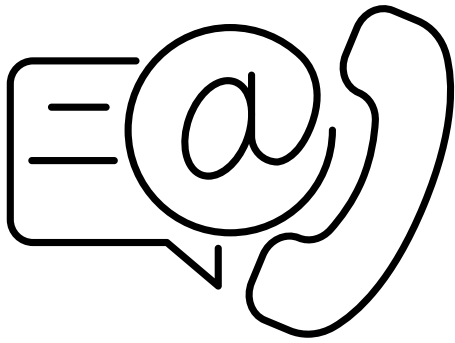


There are generally three types of students who participate in the Explorer Shadow Program:
